Introducing the first inline, fan-free draft inducer specifically designed for residential use on wood stoves (model DCWS-610) and inserts (model DCWI-610). This VESTA Award winning product preheats the flue to hundreds of degrees in just minutes. It's completely silent because there's no fan, or other moving parts. There's less creosote build up in the flue; and, most importantly, no carbon monoxide laced smoke pouring into the room.

Many wood inserts have problems with draw since they're set into a cold fireplace that's separated from the house by a panel, trapping cold air in the fireplace cavity. New inserts with secondary combustion struggle to get enough heat up the flue to create draw. The DCWI is compact enough to fit almost all applications and will solve these problems. It's built with high grade 304 stainless steel for safety and durability and comes with a built-in thermostat control that will shut the heater off once the fire is going and will turn back on when the fire dies down.
